I have emailed EExAT and they have told me that there is an issue with the EExAT Parent accounts at the moment, whereby there aren't any children listed under the "Your Children" tab. They have told me that it is something that their developers are looking into at the moment and they will rectify the issue as soon as they possibly can. They have reassured me that in the meantime, parents can still view evidence that a teacher has uploaded and tagged to their child via the dashboard, and that parents can comment on evidence through this path.
